- promotes reflection and self-awareness for personal growth
- challenges common biases, assumptions and erroneous views
- is delivered by skilled faculty; Fellows who volunteer their time to teach.

OWR requirement

SET supervisors, IMG supervisors and RACS committee members are required to complete the OWR course, within six months of appointment.

By completing the OWR course you will qualify for 7 points in Category 4 - Reflective Practice.
